**MIDGET DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIPS PROVIDE FESTIVAL WITH DRAMATIC FINISH**

The Under Armour/OLA Midget "D" Championship was the first of three Midget championships to be awarded on pad 1 at the Iroquois Park Sports Centre on August 12th. The match up for the championship game was Kingston versus Peterborough. Kingston was able to take a 2-0 lead after the first period thanks to two goals by Cain Brown. Peterborough ran into some penalty trouble in the second and third period and found themselves down 6-0 with ten minutes left in the third period. Thanks to some great defense and an additional goal by Stu Johnston, Kingston went on to a 7-0 win to Claim the Under Armour/OLA Midget "D" Championship over Peterborough.

The next game to be played on Iroquois pad 1 was the Under Armour/OLA Midget "C" Championship between Sarnia and Cornwall. Sarnia got on the board first at the 12:09 mark of the first period and added another at the 6:36 mark with both goals coming from their captain Blair McFarlane. Just as it seemed Sarnia would take a 2-0 lead into the second period, Cornwall battled back to add two goals in the last three minutes of the first period with goals from Derek Lister and Brock Daze. In the second period Cornwall was held scoreless as they ran into some penalty trouble but was able to hold Sarnia to off the score sheet due to some great penalty killing. With some great defense and goaltending being displayed in the third period, Sarnia's Reece Seguin scored the game winner with 7:25 left in the game to crown Sarnia as the Under Armour/OLA Midget "C" Champions.

The final Midget Championship to be awarded at the 2012 Ontario Lacrosse Festival was the Under Armour/OLA Midget "B" Championship. The match up for this championship game included Toronto Beaches versus Windsor. Toronto was the first to get on the score sheet with a great individual effort at 14:10 of the first period by Adrian Torel-Orban. Toronto would add one more goal with less than a minute to go in the first frame by to take a 2-0 lead into the second period. The only scoring of the second period would come within a three minute time span where Windsor would tie the game with two quick goals by Chase Kavanaugh and Noah Bushnell. The third period was a great defensive battle until 6:04 of the third period when Andrew Garant of Windsor added his second point of the game and first goal to give his team a 3-2 lead. Although time was not on their side, Toronto battled back to tie the game with 1:31 left with a goal from Marcus Minichello to push the game to overtime. In the extra ten minute frame Windsor was able to add two goals coming from Brendan Wallace and Noah Bushnell to take the Under Armour/OLA Midget "B" Championship.
